WLSA Executive Minutes, August 11, 2008

Meeting called to order at 7:15 pm

We were not able to achieve a quorum for this meeting so we focused our time on current mail, the next newsletter and on further organizing the August 24, 2008 open house.

Mail:

- ❖ A \$25.00 cheque was received from Bill Fawcet in memory of Darrel Westerman. A receipt will be sent to Bill.
- ❖ A \$5000.00 cheque was received from the Fraser Basin Council Society for the Tisdall Lake Boat Dock & Toilet Facility. The funds will be forwarded to the Horsefly Community Association and a receipt will be requested.
- ❖ Two invoices were received from Caldwell Industries in the amount of \$281.24 for the purchase of clay targets for the club.
- ❖ Two invoices were received from Central Cariboo Disposal Services Ltd, one in the amount of \$30.45, dated 2008Jun28 & one in the amount of \$15.49, dated 2008Jul28.
- ❖ An invoice was received from Canada Post in the amount of \$127.05 regarding post office box renewal fees.
- ❖ A report was received from Interior Health on the quality of our drinking water. All is fine.
- ❖ An invoice was received in the amount of \$1222.80, from End of the Roll for the vinyl flooring for the clubhouse kitchen.
- ❖ A Credit Union bank statement was received regarding the WLSA for the period ending 2008Jun30.
- ❖ A letter was received from the Royal Bank, addressed to the Cariboo Chilcotin Regional Wildlife Association. Debbie Powers-Barron to email Mike Fowler to see where this mail should be forwarded to.
- ❖ A package was received from the BCWF and given to WLSA President, Barry Jenkins. Debbie to post, on the website, a letter written by BCWF President, Mel Arnold, regarding the Provincial LEH Policy.

Open House Cariboo Archers:

- ❖ Kelly and Jess Bennett report that they will be setting up between 15 – 20 3D targets around the bottom side of the lake and away from the ranges. They will

also be setting up 2 – 3 targets behind the clubhouse at the Archery Butt. They will ribbon off the back. All shooting will be done outside unless it rains, in which case, they will use the indoor range. If using the indoor range, they will start beginners at the 10 yard line, increasing it to anywhere between 20 and 40 yards.

- Jess and Kelly will contact JOP and Mike Chesley to organize assistance for the event.
- The WLSA and the Cariboo Archers will share the cost of lunch and beverages for the event.

WLSA Open House:

- ❖ There will be opportunities every half hour to shoot shotgun
- ❖ Terry Chupa will present opportunities, again, every half hour, to shoot big bore rifle
- ❖ Caroline Chupa will present opportunities every half hour for a 22 shoot
- ❖ There is also a possibility of a hand gun shoot
- ❖ If visitors would like to shoot in excess of the allotted half hour, they can pay for their clays, etc
- ❖ Barry and Judy Jenkins will be running a CORE course during the open house which will present opportunities for CORE participants to participate in the open house
- ❖ A hotdog and pop lunch is being provided.
- ❖ Lorne Barron to contact Jason Yochman to see if he will be interested in providing a display of his furs
- ❖ The WLSA will advertise with CKWL, both on AM and FM and will also advertise this event in the Tribune and the Cariboo Advisor
- ❖ The WLSA will be displaying the ARGO
- ❖ Debbie Powers-Barron to do up a poster advertising this event and Lorne Barron will distribute the poster to various organizations and businesses
- ❖ Debbie will send copies of the poster to Kelly and Jess Bennett and to other clubs
 - The poster is to specify that there will be assistance available for sighting in hunting rifles for both members and non members

Newsletter:
